4. The event is open to:- All fully elected members of the organising Club.
5. All drivers and navigators must produce a club membership card

7. Classes:-  
The event will consist of three classes as follows:-  
**Experts:-** Crews who have elected to use the expert handouts.  
**Novice:-** Crews where the navigator has completed more than three 12 cars.  
**Beginner:-** Crews where the navigator has not completed three 12 cars.  
All vehicles must comply with MSA technical regulations.
