1. The Loughborough Car Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans Autotest. On Tuesday 8th March 2011 at Park Hill Golf Club, Seagrave LE12 7NG.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sport Association Ltd., (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FISA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the club may issue for the event.
3. An RAC MSA Permit has been requested
4. The event is open to:- All fully elected members of the organising Club, Matlock MC and Coalville Car Club
5. All competitors and drivers must produce the relevant club membership card
6. The programme of the meeting will be:- Start between 19.00 and 20.00. Finish at 21.00 approximately.
7. Public roads will not be used as link sections. There will be at least 4 tests on private land.
8. Classes:-
The event will consist of three classes as follows:-
Class A Short wheel base, up to and including 95in.
Class B Long wheel base, over 95 in.
Class C Anything with 4x4 and/or LSD.
All vehicles must comply with MSA technical regulations.

Awards will be presented as follows at the end of the year, based upon the accumulated total of the years events: (if this is a success we might run a couple more)

1st in each class (**subject to a minimum of 3 entries in the class**)
